- We drive past **Gefion fountain**, the largest monument in the Danish capital, and let ourselves be enchanted the **Amalienborg palace**, the residence of the queen where we stop for a few photos.
- We continue our tour as far as the **picturesque district of Nyhavn** with its colourful wood, brick and mortar houses, famous wooden boats and the romantic sailing ships moored at the quays.
- We then move on to the island of Amager, the last stop on our excursion, to visit the charming picturesque **fishing town of Dragør**, one of the best preserved in Denmark.

- We move on to the port of Copenhagen to admire the symbol of the city, a lovely bronze statue nestled on a rock: the **Little Mermaid Statue**, the protagonist of one of Hans Christian Andersen's most famous fairy tales. Here, we have some free time available to take some beautiful photos and immerse ourselves in the atmosphere of the Danish capital.
- Our tour continues with the historic city of **Roskilde** to admire two of its great sights.
- The first stop is the **Viking Ship Museum**, where we go on a journey into the history of northern warriors among their extraordinary ships. We marvel at five fascinating types of ship, from trading ships to war ships, sunk off Skuldelev in 1070 and brought back to light in 1962. In the museum, we have the opportunity of admiring other marvellous ships, which are perfect reconstructions of Viking ships. We continue with the majestic **Roskilde Cathedral**, the main burial site for Danish monarchs. It was the first Gothic church to be made of bricks, a style that was promoted all over northern Europe. We remain speechless in front of this magnificent cathedral, a true architectural marvel declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Exploring **Copenhagen on foot** is the best way to discover the city's **connection with the water**. A paradox? Not at all. From the statue of **the Little Mermaid**, heroine of children, to the **Gefion fountain**, which evokes ancient myths, the **royal residences** with their **gardens**, and the **Nyhavn canal**: with your **guide**, you will discover the aquatic DNA of this city.

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### The programme

- Walk with your guide to the **Little Mermaid statue**, which has been the symbol of the city since 1913. Here, a passion for the sea is instilled at an early age, even if only by listening to **Hans Christian Andersen's fairy tale**.
- From fairy tales to myth: in front of **Gefion Fountain**, discover the legendary origins of Zealand: a patch of land stolen from the sea with an ox-drawn plow. It is the island upon which the city rests!
- It stretches to **Churchill Park**, where water brings life to flowers and meadows, and the **Frederiksstad district**, with the **Amalienborg Palace**, residence of the Danish royal family. Guess what: it is only separated from the harbor basin by **The Amalie Garden**.
- Along the **Nyhavn canal**, the old port, a host of colorful houses are reflected in the water, while **Rosenborg Castle** is mirrored in the lake of its **gardens**: a home for fish, geese and swans.
- But the last piece of your puzzle is **Kastellet**, a 17th-century citadel surrounded by water. Here in **Copenhagen**, everything – even the most monumental structures – seem to float.

#### In a nutshell

On this excursion we learn about the history of Copenhagen's most iconic locations, symbols of the city that have become famous around the world.

#### Main stops

#### The programme

- We reach **Copenhagen**, the enchanting capital of the world's oldest kingdom, a city where history, tradition and the modern world are interwoven with the magic of fairy tales.
- Our first 'port of call' is the world-famous **statue of the Little Mermaid inspired by the story by Hans Christian Andersen**. Since 1913, she has sat on the harbour rocks welcoming travellers from all over

the world and inspiring them with her tale of love and sacrifice. But there is more to her story than fairy tales: covered in pink paint, twice decapitated, deprived of an arm, narrowly escaping being blown to pieces, and even transported to China for the Shanghai Expo – our dear Little Mermaid has led a colourful life!

- Next stop on the tour is the home of the Queen, **Amalienborg Palace**: four identical buildings, guarded by soldiers in traditional bearskin hats. In the palace grounds, the **statue of King Frederick V**, on horseback depicted as a Roman emperor, is considered one of the most important equestrian statues in the world.
- Next on our itinerary is **Christiansborg Palace** on the islet of Slotsholmen, which, being home to Denmark's most important institutions, is fittingly nicknamed the 'Island of Power'.

- This is why the atmosphere still retains its old seafaring air, but with a modern touch added by the **museums, art galleries and restaurants** that enliven the atmosphere.
- The **fish market** is even more vibrant, and has been one of Norway's most popular since 1200: oysters, shrimps and other **delicacies caught in the Arctic waters** are displayed on the stalls with their myriad colors and scents.

## SIGHTSEEING TOUR OF BERGEN AND SCENIC FUNICULAR RIDE

#### In a nutshell

An exceptional tour on which we discover the main attractions and history of Bergen – once the hub of the Hanseatic League, now a vibrant, commercial centre that retains its traditional maritime air – before turning our attention to the scenic treasures on show in this landscape of fjords and mountains, with an unforgettable ride in the famous Fløibanen funicular.

#### Main stops

- Håkonshallen, Rosenkrantz Tower and Bryggen Hanseatic Wharf
- Fløibanen Funicular, Mount Fløyen
- Central Park and Lake
- Residential area, wooden houses, gardens, Royal Residence, the wooden Fantoft Stavkirke (stave church)

#### The programme

- Our tour begins with passing by **King Haakon's Hall** (Håkonshallen), the imperial residence with adjoining banquet hall built by King Håkon Håkonsson in 1261 and the nearby **Rosenkrantz Tower** (Rosenkrantzårnet), which was built around 1560 by the Governor of Bergen, Erik Rosenkrantz, to serve both as a residence and a fortified tower. Today it even incorporates part of the keep (1273) of King Magnus the Lawmender and Jørgen Hansson's fortress of 1520.
- We will stop on at the picturesque old **wharf district of Bryggen** ('bryggen' in Norwegian means 'wharf'), which was built around 1350 by the Hanseatic League. It is the most picturesque district of Bergen, extending along the eastern side of the port of Vågen, with its long parallel rows of colourful



buildings. Once, these buildings were used as offices, homes and stores by the German merchants of the Hanseatic League. Today the Bryggen District is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site and boasts shops, restaurants, cafés and artisan workshops. We wander around the alleys between the picturesque warehouses that line the street and along the seafront to enjoy the quaint atmosphere of this neighbourhood.

- We then arrive at the **Fløibanen funicular** station, which has been in operation since 1910. Once aboard, we are transported up the 26% gradient to an altitude of 320 metres a journey of about 8 minutes to reach the summit of **Mount Fløien** (one of the seven mountains that surround Bergen, its name derives from the wind vane placed at the summit many centuries ago to indicate the force and direction of the wind to sailors entering or leaving the port below). Mount Fløien is very popular with the inhabitants of Bergen as a recreation area all year round. From the summit the view is truly impressive: we can see the heart of Bergen at our feet and looking to the west, on a clear day, you can also see the North Sea, and the neighbouring archipelagos.
  - We take the funicular back down, and after boarding the coach, we cross the **Fish Market** square, with its seafood, flowers, fruit and vegetables and souvenir stalls and we head for the **central park** and the **lake**.
  - We then go through the **residential area**, admiring the well-preserved **wooden houses**, the **gardens** and the **Royal Residence** on our way to **Fantoft Stavkirke**. This wooden **stave church**, located in an enchanting wooded area to the south of Bergen, was rebuilt in 1992 after a terrible fire and is the exact replica of the original building which dated back to 1150. In the Middle Ages, in Norway, there were at least 800 of these typical stave churches; today there are only 30 remaining.
  - Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
  - In the event of inclement weather, the view from the platform of the funicular may not be ideal; in these conditions you are also advised to wear appropriate clothing.
- The funicular is very popular among both locals as well as visitors; therefore, long lines at the Funicular should be expected.?

- We are rewarded for reaching the **highest point of the itinerary** located at 275 feet above sea level with enchanting views over the city and the fjord surrounded by majestic mountains.
- With our body and spirit reinvigorated by this thrilling adventure, tour ends in town

Bergen flourished thanks to the export of fish (mostly dried fish) which was the city's main product in the Middle Ages. Even after Oslo became capital in 1299, Bergen continued to grow as a business centre, becoming the largest in Norway.
- Our tour begins with some of the city's most important and symbolic landmarks, including **King Haakon's Hall** (Håkonshallen), the imperial residence with adjoining banquet hall built by King Håkon Håkonsson between 1247 and 1261, and the **Rosenkrantz Tower** (Rosenkrantzårnet), built around 1560 by the Governor of Bergen Tower, Erik Rosenkrantz, to serve as both as a residence and a fortified tower.
- Our tour then continues to the other symbol of the city, the ancient and picturesque **wharf district of Bryggen** ('bryggen' in Norwegian means 'wharf'), which was built around 1350 by the Hanseatic

League. It is the most enchanting neighbourhood of the city and extends along the eastern side of the port of Vågen, with long parallel rows of coloured buildings with sloping roofs (and leaning walls, in many cases), which are built with rough wooden planks on stacked-stone or wooden foundations. In the past, these buildings were used as offices, homes and stores and were used by the German merchants of the Hanseatic League, which enjoyed a trade monopoly with Norway. Today the Bryggen District is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site and boasts shops, restaurants, cafés and artisan workshops.

- Passing by the bustling **Fish Market** (Fisketorget), we head for the **Nordnes Peninsula**, with its typical 19th-century white wooden houses. The **Bergen Aquarium** (Akvariet) at the tip of the peninsula, boasts one of the largest collections of marine and freshwater fish and invertebrates in Europe, in addition to seals and penguins; in the tropical section there are crocodiles, snakes, turtles and monkeys.
- As we continue on our way, we enjoy the splendid panorama that opens up on both sides of the port and, before returning to the ship, we cross the Fish Market once again and head for the **Øvregaten**, the oldest street in Bergen.
- Those who wish can stay a little longer at the Fish Market and return to the ship independently.
- The tour is suitable for people with disabilities and those with mobility problems as long as they can board the coach autonomously.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.

- After admiring the buildings of the old **Bryggen Hanseatic Wharf** and the **Fish Market**, we proceed to **Os**, a village on the **Bjornefjord**, 30 km south of the city.
- From here we begin a brief panoramic tour of the fjord, during which we are stunned by the spectacular view of the islands and the snow-capped mountains. We then reach **Hatvik**, where we take the ferry to cross the fjord to **Venjanaset**, on the opposite side.
- Our journey then leads us through small villages set in typical, west-coast scenery as we proceed to **Mundheim** and the **Hardangerfjord**, one of the most well-known Norwegian fjords, which lies framed by mountains reflected in the clear water and is famous for its many orchards.
- Our panoramic coach tour continues with a spectacular view of the mountains on the opposite side of the fjord. Weather permitting, we can even see the **Folgefonna Glacier** the third largest in Norway which covers an area of 203 square kilometres.
- We reach the **village of Øystese**, which sits in the bay of the fjord against a backdrop of high mountains, surrounded by green farms. We stop here for **lunch**, before returning to the **village of Norheimsund**, where we head inland to the **Steinsdal Waterfall** which has a sheer drop of 50 metres where we can cross the valley without getting wet.
- After going through many tunnels, we come to the **Tokagjel Gorge** and the **Kvamskogen Mountain Plateau**, a favoured dining and picnic spot among the inhabitants of Bergen. Indeed, there are numerous wooden chalets here and the area is ideal for hiking in summer and skiing during the winter and spring.
- We then go down along the fjord again, before going up to **Gullbotn**, where there is a closer recreational area with ski pistes and ski jumps.
- From here we go down to the **Soerfjord**. Across the water, on the opposite side of the fjord lies **Osterøy**, the largest island on the western coast.
- Our tour proceeds towards the **northern suburbs of Bergen** and before returning to the port we have the opportunity to admire the typical architecture of **Sandviken Bay**.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- This excursion is purely scenic and involves long stretches travelling by coach on winding roads (about 6 hours).

- Thrilling RIB (rigid-inflatable boat) excursion
- Visit of Bergen and of Bryggen district, a UNESCO World Heritage Site
- Lively tourist and trading port
- Breathtaking views of the fjords
- High-speed and pure adrenaline
- Free time in the city centre

#### **The programme**

- The first exciting event on this tour is meeting our skilful captain who, after introducing himself, illustrates the characteristics of our rigid-inflatable boat known as **RIB** and gives the necessary safety instructions as well as handing out the special safety equipment. The time has come to set off for a once-in-a-lifetime experience.
- As we sail along the sea in front of Bergen, the captain shows us the city and its port. It is a privileged observation point from where we can appreciate the **wharf area in Bryggen**, a district famous for its colourful wooden façades and declared a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. From here, we can also observe the seven hills surrounding Bergen and the **incessant tourist and trading activities in the port**.
- The wonder at this marvellous view is followed by the thrill of a motorboat ride to the fjords. The scenery gradually changes offering **breathtaking views** of the coastal islets and islands further off the coast linked to the mainland via majestic suspended bridges.

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- The tour then transforms into a shot of **pure adrenaline**: the motor roars and the captain makes us experience new emotions as we speed across the sea. The intensity of this experience remains etched in our memory together with the images of the surrounding scenery.

- We will then head to **Oppheim lake** and stop again for photos at **Tvinde waterfall** before returning to Voss and then to the ship.

It was collected and sent down the valley using the *løypestreng*, a cable that stretched to the nearest barn.
- Our destination is the **spectacular Storsæter waterfall**, which gushes out from a height of 30 metres forming a large curve so we can walk right under it!
- After admiring this incredible view, we will hike down to **Westerås farm**, which lies on a projection jutting out over Geiranger.
- Uninhabited during winter and at the beginning of spring due to the danger of avalanches, it is a hive of activity during the summer months and it is here that we will be served **a drink**.
- After relaxing for a while, we will have some **free time** to look around the farm before returning on foot to Hole Camping where our coach will be waiting to take us back to the quay in Geiranger.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.
- The walk to the waterfall takes around 1 hour (3 km) and covers rough ground and steep sections so it may be tiring.
- We recommend wearing walking shoes and suitable clothing.

- We will cover the full length of the fjord, around 15 km, starting at sea level and rising to the summit of the **surrounding snow-capped mountains**: we will be amazed by the **breathtaking views and steep, rugged cliffs** with powerful **waterfalls** (such as the 'Seven Sisters' or 'Bridal Veil Falls'), which create light veils of mist that produce an endless display of ever-changing rainbows, which will leave us lost for words.
- We will fly to **Mount Dalsnibba**, 1500 metres high, which towers over the tourist town of Geiranger, located at the end of the fjord. We will be able to see **small farms** from up here, nestled in the foothills of the mountains, and higher up **glaciers** with ice caves and small icy waterfalls.
- As we fly back along the fjord to return to base, we will notice the lush vegetation beneath us, a fundamental part of this wild and exciting natural landscape.

- At first, the path climbs and crosses over the waterfall on a wooden bridge.
- At this point we find ourselves standing face to face with the massive glacier.
- We'll then walk back the same way to the mountain lodge, where we'll enjoy an **excellent lunch**.
- Back on our journey, we cross the valley alongside the extraordinarily beautiful lake towards Stryn.
- We climb the **mountain road to Stryn**, which used to link eastern Norway with the west.
- Our return journey to Geiranger runs through quite a few tunnels, and we make a final stop at **Flydal** to take a few snapshots of our ship, waiting for us in the fjord.

A group of **local farmers** will welcome you to their **300-year-old summer farm**, not far from a **UNESCO World Heritage fjord**, to share their memories and traditions with you, along with **handmade delicacies** that taste of open-air pastures and a hard, simple life. A real return to the roots of this place.

### Main stops

- Eagle Road by coach, with panoramic views of the Geirangerfjord and the Knivsflå alpine farm
- The Seven Sisters and the Suitor waterfalls: photo stop
- Visit to the Herdalssetra or Dale summer farm
- Tasting of goat's cheeses and desserts, made by the farmers
- Heregga peak and Herdøla river: photo stops on the way back

- The start is all adrenaline and amazement: the **Geirangerfjord** getting smaller and smaller below, as the coach climbs the **11 hairpin bends of the vertiginous Eagle Road**, and your **local guide** regales you with facts and legends about the place.
- There is the moving tale about **the Seven Sisters and the Suitor waterfalls** and the story of the **Knivsflå alpine farm** - unbelievable, yet true.
- But not as incredible as that of the centuries-old **Herdalssetra farm**, a remarkably beautiful and harsh place, where living means adapting to the rules and rhythms of nature.
- The **farmers** who welcome you do this every summer, when they take the livestock to pasture:

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**cows, sheep, goats and Fjord horses**, reared in the wild.

- In their **wooden huts**, cocooned by the warmth of the wood-burning stoves, they will reveal some of their tips for rural living: the turf covering the roofs, the importance of the Heregga peak...
- And then, they will also share the fruits of their labor with you: **you'll sample cheeses and desserts made from goat's milk using the old method**, before heading back to the sea.
- The experience includes sections on foot over steep and slippery ground. As such, for your own safety, please wear comfortable, non-slip shoes.
- Out of season or if the road to the Herdalssetra farm is rendered impassable by the winter thaw, you will be welcomed by the farmers of the DaleFarm, located further down in the valley.
- This is one of the most popular experiences so book early.

- Along the path we will see **three seter (traditional mountain farm huts) and numerous mountain lakes**, reaching a maximum altitude of 550 metres above sea level
- During the climb we will make a brief stop to admire the **Stryn lake**, which reflects the imposing mountains of Skåla and Lofjellet and several smaller glaciers.
- We then descend down the path in the direction of **Flo, an enchanting village sprinkled with fruit trees**.
- Here we will board the coach once more and continue our trip along the banks of the 15 km-long **Stryn lake**, which is famous for its turquoise reflections. The new Stryn mountain road passes through several tunnels making it accessible even during the winter season.
- Having reached the shore **opposite the mountains**, we continue west along the banks of lake Djupvatn. At its furthest point, we turn and take a steep toll road to reach the **panoramic view point of Dalsnibba**.
- Having admired the **unforgettable landscape** that the observation point offers us, we descend to Geiranger, making a **stop for photos at the Flydal Gorge**.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- We recommend you wear sturdy shoes that are suitable for walking.

- Our next destination is a photostop at the famous **Trollstigen** or 'Trolls' Path', an engineering feat consisting of an extremely narrow scenic road with 11 hairpin bends and a hair-raising steep gradient, surrounded by majestic mountains and stunning waterfalls.

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- Back down at the fjord, we will take the ferry back across it and stop at the **Ørnesvingen viewpoint**, which literally means Eagles' Turn, where we can admire and take photos of the Geirangerfjord and the **Seven Sisters waterfall**, so called because it splits into seven rivulets over the rock face.
- Then we will travel along the last section of the road and stop in **Geiranger**, our final destination.
- The excursion starts in Hellesylt and ends in Geiranger.

## *Haugesund* VISIT TO THE ARQUEBUS WAR MUSEUM

### In a nutshell

A unique excursion through history and the present day, ideal for those who love the mountains but want to see more than just the countryside: from the most spectacular landscapes the Norwegian fjords have to offer to a museum dedicated to the Second World War.

### Main stops

- The city of Haugesund and the pristine surrounding countryside
- The Arquebus War Museum
- The Steinsfjellet viewpoint
- The Haraldshaugen national monument

### The programme

- This scenic excursion takes us on a journey exploring the area east of the coastal town of **Haugesund**. Along with its spectacular natural landscape, Haugesund boasts a unique and fascinating history: not only was the Statue of Liberty made using copper from one of its mines, but it can also claim to be the original ~~fatherland~~ of Marilyn Monroe, whose grandfather worked locally as a baker before emigrating to the United States. Not bad for a town that was only recognised as a separate municipality in 1854!
- The highlight of our time in Haugesund is a visit to the **Arquebus War Museum** (Arquebus Krigshistorisk Museum). Located in the inner stretch of the Førresfjord, this museum brings to life various events associated with the Second World War, from the everyday lives of local people, the

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merchant navy's contribution to the war effort, defence operations and the 1940 invasion, the enemy positions along the coast, the liberation, the fall of Berlin in 1945, and the allied victory in Europe. During our visit, we learn all sorts of fascinating details. For instance, the word Arquebus comes from the code name adopted by a local resistance fighter for communications made using a clandestine radio transmitter. The museum is the largest in Norway, with over 2,000 m<sup>2</sup> of exhibit space housed in an old farm building. The exhibits include manikins dressed in genuine uniforms and historical costumes.

- Following our visit to the museum, we make our way to the **Steinsfjellet viewpoint** which, at 227 metres above sea level, and with breathtaking views of Haugesund and the surrounding area, is a favourite spot among locals for walks and trips to the country.
- The next stop is at the **Haraldshaugen**, a national monument erected in 1872 to commemorate the thousand-year anniversary of the Battle of Hafrsfjord, which was fought and won by King Harald Hårfagre (Harald Fairhair) at Hafrsfjord near Stavanger in 872, leading to the unification of Norway. Harald Hårfagre established his court at Avaldsnes, on the nearby island of Karmøy, while the monument stands at a location believed to be the site of his burial, about 3 km north of the centre of Haugesund.

You will complete your tour of Hamburg with an outside visit of the citys famous landmark Michel - St. Michaelis Church. The 'Kramer Amtsstuben', a well preserved complex of restored buildings, presenting the living conditions in the early 18th century will be also shown in detail.

## **PANORAMIC TOUR OF KIEL AND HISTORIC LANDMARK IN LABOE (ending at the airport)**

### **In a nutshell**

From the port city of Kiel to the historic town of Laboe, on the eastern bank of the Kiel Fjord.

### **Main stops**

- Kiel: major places of interest in the city, City Hall, Kiel Canal
- Laboe: Naval Memorial to the Sailors who died in battle and exhibition inside, U995 submarine with museum

### **The programme**

- We leave the port to start our panoramic tour of the city of **Kiel**. The capital of the Federal State of Schleswig-Holstein boasts a long tradition as a maritime city and port, which pervades daily life.
- Our route winds past the **main points of interest** in the city, including the **City Hall** and the spectacular **Kiel Canal**, which links the North Sea to the Baltic Sea.
- At the end of our city tour, our coach will take us to the eastern shore of the Kiel Fjord to the town of **Laboe**, where we visit the **Memorial to the Sailors who were killed in battle**. The tower was first erected to commemorate the soldiers of the German Navy who died in the First World War. Later, it was also dedicated to the sailors who died in the Second World War. In 1954, it became a memorial to all the fallen from the Navies of all nationalities.
- After an interesting visit to the **exhibition inside the monument**, we climb to the top of the building to enjoy the **spectacular view** that unfolds before us.
- Lastly, the **U995 submarine**, one of the dreaded U-Boats that destroyed the allied ships in the north-eastern Atlantic, awaits us on the nearby beach. Today, it houses a museum where we can learn about some of the aspects of the hard life of the crew on board submarines.
- Our visit to the memorial is over and we set off by coach for Hamburg airport.
- We recommend wearing comfortable shoes.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.
- The tour guides will leave the group at the end of our tour of Kiel. The journey to the airport does not include a guide.
- This excursion is reserved for guests who disembark at Kiel and whose flights depart after 4.00 p.m.

First of all, our route runs alongside the **Lake formed by the River Alster** in the city centre, and then crosses the residential districts and the **Jungfernstieg**, the famous fashion street, lined with luxury boutiques and shopping malls.
- We drive past the **Renaissance buildings of the City Hall and Stock Exchange** and venture into the **more modern part of the city**, with its parks and gardens, the television tower, 19th century buildings and much more.
- Weather and traffic permitting, we will have the opportunity to leave the coach and make a few photo stops.
- Our next stop will be a visit of the exterior of **St. Michael's Church**, affectionately known as Michel by the inhabitants of Hamburg; this is one of the main Protestant churches in the city, and one of the most important architectural structures in Germany.



- Our tour ends in the **Krameramtsstuben** area, a complex of 5 buildings, built between 1620 and 1676 by the merchants' guild to provide homes for traders' widows. They are well preserved and give us an idea of what life was like at the beginning of the 18th century.
- Afterwards our coach will bring you to Hamburg airport.
